



## 13<sup>th</sup> annual Call-on Congress March 17-19, 2019

### Travel Information

The 2019 Call-on Congress host hotel will once again be the [Key Bridge Marriott](#), located at 1401 Lee Highway, Arlington, VA. The following information will assist attendees traveling to the Key Bridge Marriott.

#### Airports

The closest airport is Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA). DCA is approximately 4 miles from the Key Bridge Marriott.

Other nearby airports include:

- Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD) – 24 miles away
- Baltimore/Washington International Airport (BWI) – 38 miles away

It is important to note that traffic on most major roads in and around Washington, DC are heavily congested during extended morning and evening rush hours. If it is at all possible, we highly recommend guest flights arrive/depart via DCA.

#### Metro

The Washington DC area Metro system is a common way for locals and visitors alike to travel around the region. Guests new to the system must first purchase a SmarTrip fare card. SmarTrip cards are available at vending machines at every station for \$2.00 – cash and credit card are both accepted – plus the cost of the fare you choose to add.

Traveling via Metro from DCA to the Key Bridge Marriott –

- The airport Metro station is accessible from Terminals B and C.
- Take any blue line train towards Largo Town Center.
- Get off five stops later at the Rosslyn station.
- Upon exiting the station, walk down N. Moore Street towards 19<sup>th</sup> St North.
- After passing 19<sup>th</sup> St North, continue down N. Moore Street until you see a stairwell on your left hand side (near the entrance to the Continental Pool Lounge). This stairwell will take you to the skywalk that crosses over Rt. 66. From the skywalk, navigate to the hotel (large 13 story building in front of you).
- If you prefer to not take the skywalk, you can cross under it via Ft. Myer Drive towards the hotel.
- The walk from the Rosslyn Metro to the Key Bridge Marriott is approximately 0.3 miles.



### **Uber/Lyft/Taxi Cabs**

Washington, DC is full of ride-sharing options – from Uber to Lyft to your every day taxi cab. All are good options.

A typical ride from DCA to the Key Bridge Marriott will take anywhere from 10-20 minutes, depending on traffic. You can expect to pay \$15-22 per ride.

### **Parking at the Key Bridge Marriott**

Onsite parking is available at the Key Bridge Marriott for \$25 per day.

### **Room Check-in**

Please note that check-in at the Key Bridge Marriott begins at 4PM. Check-out is at 12PM.
